## New London Harbour Towers Helps Reveal a New View to the City of New London

A recent oil tank restoration enhances the shore views of the city

New London, CT (Vocus) September 1, 2010

The decommissioned oil tanks, visible from the Bank Street-facing condos are in the process of being dismantled and the artwork is being applied to the remaining largest tank to better blend it into the landscape. This mural will join several others that have been created and added to the New London streetscape over the course of the summer
